Mentee Profile

- Elected female leaders in Co-operatives aged between 18- and 40-years old aspiring to advance their leadership skills and grow further in co-operative organizations or
- Women employed by co-operative organizations aged between 18- and 40-years old aspiring to take up leadership positions in Co-operative organizations in Kenya or

Application Requirements

- Mentee must already be associated to Co-operatives, e.g., through membership or employment, specialized education in co-operative field, civil servants at Co-op Government institutions, elected Co-operative leaders etc
- Mentees must have access to stable internet for online sessions, video conferences etc.
- Mentees must be able speak, write and follow presentations in English language.
- Through a motivation letter, a video clip or a short story about yourself please illustrate:
 - *Your commitment to the core principles of co-operatives and co-operative values*
 - *Your conviction that female leadership matters in developing communities through co-operatives.*
 - *Your passion in playing a significant leadership role in your co-operative organization.*
 - *You believe that co-operatives play a critical role in supporting women's economic empowerment on community level*
