This program is to accelerate leadership development of Kenyan women in co-operative organizations through mentorship and exposure to key stakeholders.

Application Requirements

- Leaders in the Co-operative movement Aged between 30 and ideally 60 years old and operating in the respective partner country.
- Has at least 10 years' experience in leadership; preferably supporting women in Co-operative environments.
- Possess a profound comprehension of women-related challenges and the ability to mentor women towards enhancing their life skills effectively, while also cherishing the success of other leaders.
- Exhibit a diverse network within the cooperative community, particularly with policy makers, fostering collaborative relationship and promoting sustainable engagements.

- A technical proposal, with a detailed workplan.
- A Financial Proposal stating your compensation expectations in Kenya Shilling based on hourly rates.
